1. Division/Agency Name: Divisions of Waste Management, Air Quality and Water Quality

2. Current Situation:

Division of Waste Management

- Sean Morris arrived on-site at 7 a.m. Work on-site began around 07:45.
- 7:55 a.m. USES and CTEH employees added mineral oil to two drums containing Sodium Metal and secured the containers.
- 8:15 a.m. load of non-hazardous material left site for disposal. 8:30 a.m. received updated non-hazardous inventory sheet from EQ personnel and copies of the non-hazardous manifests of all shipments to date.
- 10 a.m. second load of non-hazardous material left site. A total of six loads of non-hazardous materials has been shipped to date.
- As of 11:45 a.m. pressure-washing activities still ongoing. Approximately halfway finished with pressure-washing acid bay. Oxidizer bay will be the next/last bay pressure washed.
- DWM issued an Order of Immediate Suspension of Provisions of Hazardous Waste Management Permit to EQ early afternoon 10/25. Under this order, EQ will not be permitted to bring or accept any additional hazardous or non-hazardous wastes of any type onto the site for storage, treatment or any other purpose for the duration of the order, but will still be permitted to continue its clean-up activities.

Division of Air Quality

- DAQ's toxics branch has completed the final version of its report on air quality results from the fire and its aftermath.

3. Departmental Operational Priorities:

Division of Waste Management: Continue to monitor site activities.

Division of Water Quality: Tomorrow DWQ will pull samples for metals and take physical readings downstream of the site on the unnamed tributary that flows adjacent to the EQ site before it joins Middle Creek.

4. Divisional Operational Priorities: Same as 3.
