Description

In accordance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, specifically Rule 15A NCAC 13B .1603(a)(1)(E), a proposed substantial change in the tonnage rate for an existing municipal solid waste landfill (MSWLF) requires a new facility permit. This draft permit reflects the request by The Chambers Development MSW Landfill (Anson Landfill) to increase current approved tonnage rate of 1500 tons per day be increased to 3000 tons per day. This draft permit does not authorize the construction of additional landfill disposal capacity, change the service area, total volume, or characteristics of waste stream established in the previous permit.

The Division of Waste Management has prepared a draft permit that is now available for public review and comment. The draft permit proposes no other changes to the existing permit. The landfill is located on Allied Road, north of US Hwy 74 and approximately 1.5 miles east of Polkton, in Anson County, and is permitted to dispose of non-hazardous municipal solid waste, including household waste, commercial waste, and industrial waste. The landfill is permitted to receive wastes generated in the states of North Carolina and South Carolina, consistent with the franchise approved by the Anson County Board of Commissioners.

Permit Structure

The permit is divided into two parts, the Permit to Construct, and the Permit to Operate, each consist of a list of Approved Documents, and specific conditions for the construction, operation, and monitoring of the landfill units. Owners are required to submit Permit Amendment applications for construction and operation of each stage of operation. This Permit to Operate will be issued for a 5 year increments of operation.

Public Comment Period

North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules require that the public be given an opportunity to comment on a draft permit for a facility involving a substantial change in the tonnage rate. The 45-day comment period begins on February 11, 2015 and ends on April 1, 2015 at 4:00 PM.

The application and draft permit are available for review by appointment from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday-Friday, at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section, Green Square, 217 West Jones Street, Raleigh, NC 27603, NC. The administrative record including the

application, fact sheet, and draft permit may be viewed online at <http://portal.ncdenr.org/web/wm/sw>. Select the “Documents” link from the list on the left side of the page. Once redirected, enter 0403-MSWLF- in the “ID” field and then click the “Search” button.

Persons who wish to comment on the draft permit or to object to the permit issuance should submit their comments in writing by April 1, 2015 at 4:00 PM. Comments should be sent to the address shown below and include the permit number. All comments received within the 45-day period will be considered in making the final determinations regarding the permit.

PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing has been scheduled for February 23, 2015 from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM and will be held at South Piedmont Community College, Lockhart Taylor Center, Studio B, 514 N. Washington St., Wadesboro, N.C. 28170. Interested parties may submit oral or written statements and data concerning the proposed new facility permit. Persons wishing to speak may register at the hearing. Five (5) minutes will be allotted per speaker. Interested parties may submit written statements and data concerning the proposed new facility permit to the division contact at the address shown below.
